ANGELOUECONOMICS to create Global Vision Strategic Plan for Manchester

(Manchester, NH) – Manchester, New Hampshire has hired AngelouEconomics, an Austin-based Economic Consulting firm to develop their 10-year Economic Development Strategic Plan for the City’s use and implementation.
